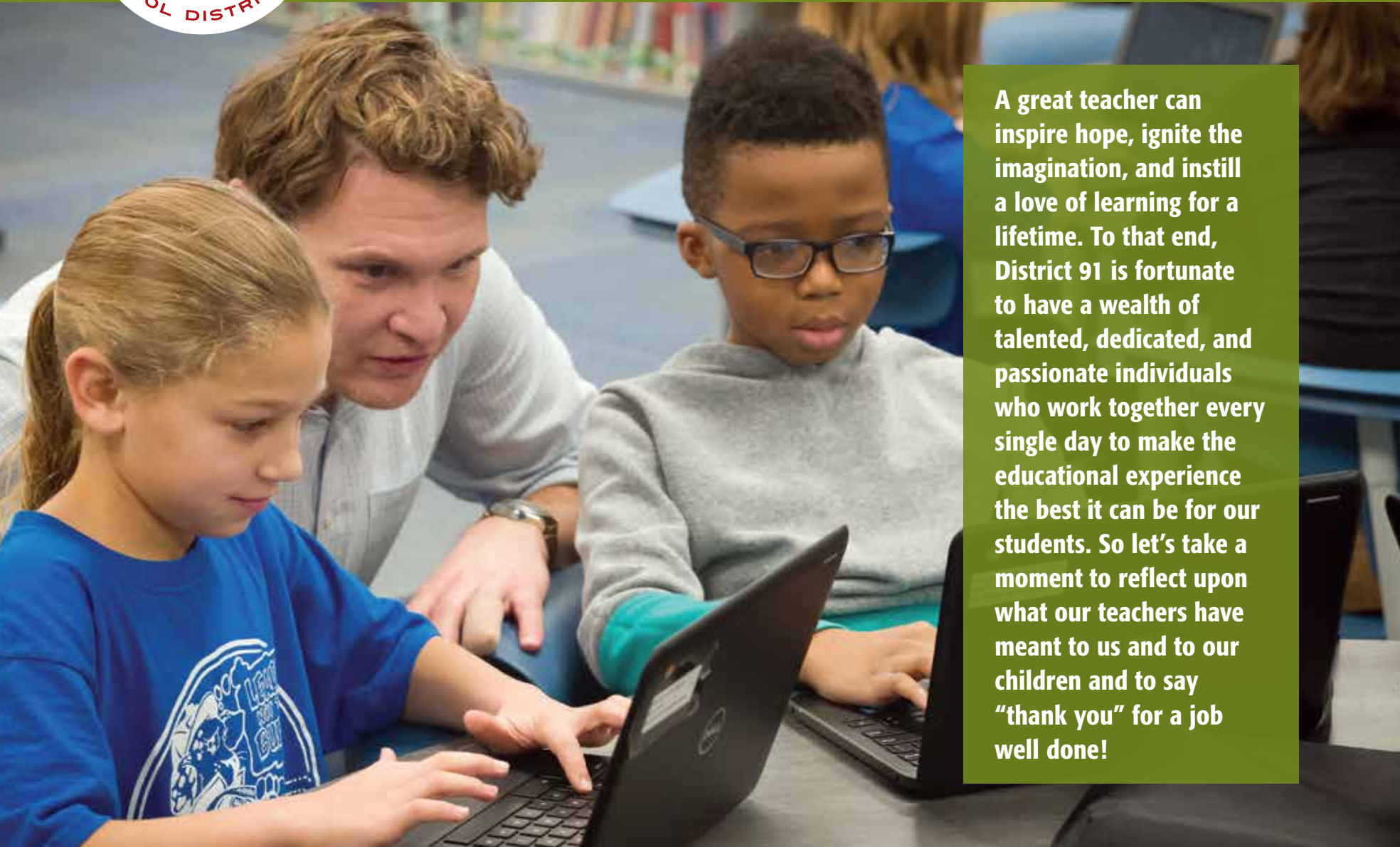




National Teacher Day!
