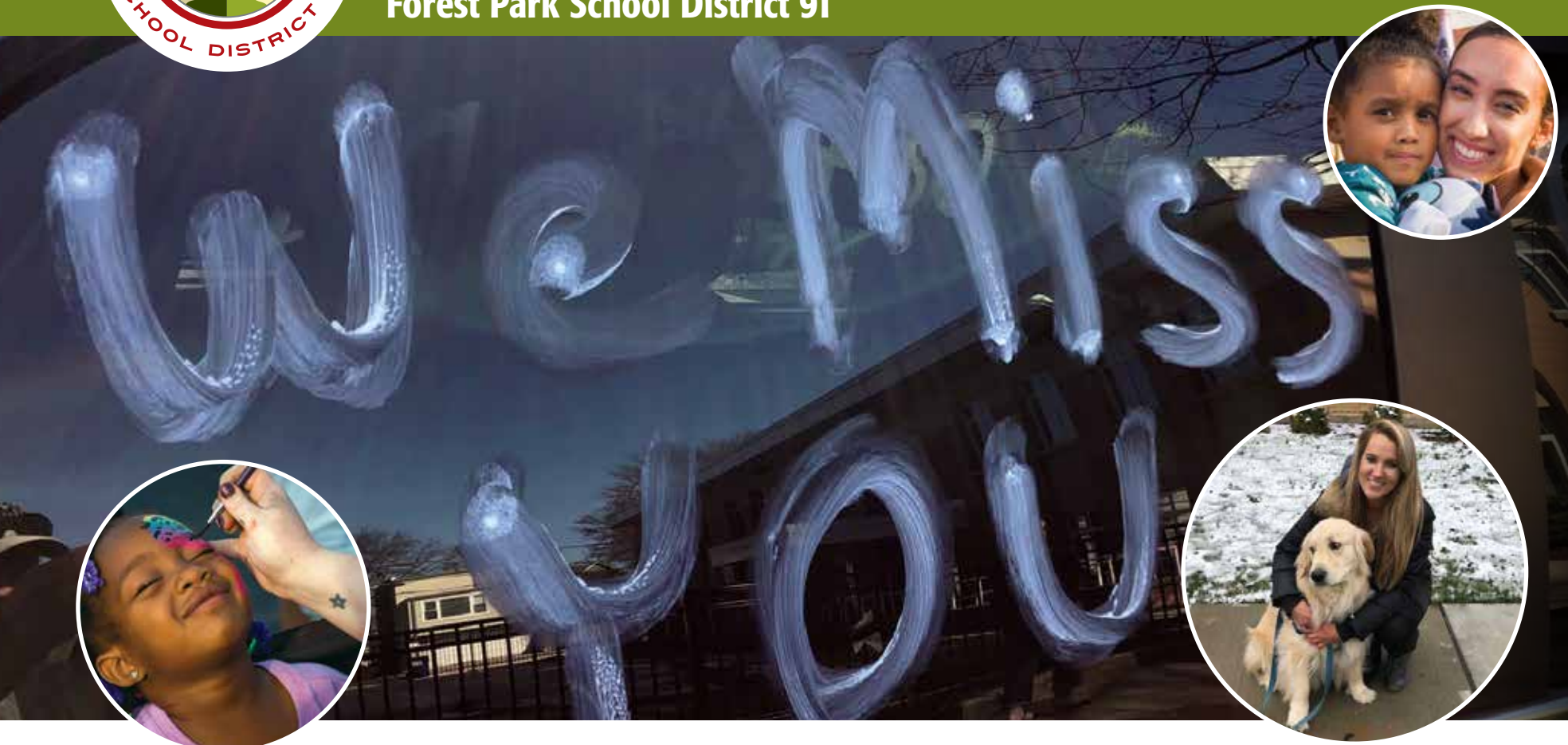




A School Year Unlike Any Other!
