The in-person Extended School Year (ESY) program is still going forward as planned for students with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

It was also the hope and intent of the district to be able to offer a remote option that would be open to all students and staffed with FPSD 91 teachers. Unfortunately, the district will not be able to provide a summer remote learning program without the necessary personnel to staff these classes.
